## “FEARLESS CONFIDENCE”

### “HOPE IS A STEADFAST ANCHOR OF THE SOUL”

- VI. The believer at this point has reached the place in faith for healing where they are practicing *diligence* and *sincerity* in their “trial of faith.”
  - A. They are sincere in their quest, which means the believer is to be real and not affected by any circumstance that arises during their “trial of faith.”
    1. This “state of being” brings “joy” and this “joy” is their strength to have the *assurance* of God’s Word for healing.
    2. This *assurance* is further strengthened by “*spiritual hope*” which we must “*development*” as a blueprint for our faith to work by.
    3. Just how powerful is this “hope?”
      - a. In Hebrews 6:19-20 AMP we read: “[Now] we have this [hope] as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul [it cannot slip and it cannot break down under whoever steps out upon it – a hope] that reaches father and enters into [the very certainty of the Presence] within the veil, V20, Where Jesus has entered in for us [in advance], a Forerunner having become a High Priest .....”.
  4. Remember, in 1 Peter 1:7-9 we are told your “trial of faith is precious in God’s sight: “**That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be**

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**found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ.” V8, Whom having not seen, you love; in whom, though now you see him not, yet believing, you rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory, V9, Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.”**

### **“FEARLESS CONFIDENCE IN THE WORD OF GOD”**

B. Between the time we definitely commit to God the healing of our body and the completion of our healing, we can, and should, learn another important lesson of faith in our Christian life.

1. That lesson is how to observe Hebrews 10: 35-36 AMP: **“Do not, therefore, fling away your fearless confidence, for it carries a great and glorious compensation of reward. V36, For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, so that you may perform and fully accomplish the will of God, and thus receive and carry away [and enjoy to the full] what is promised.”**
2. The Holy Spirit is telling us here that we as believers should have fearless confidence.
3. To make this simple we need to understand that fear itself is a feeling of agitation and anxiety caused by the presence of imminence of danger.
4. This simply means that we are not to have any agitation and anxiety over anything, including disease which most people look at as imminence of danger.
  - a. Concerning “earth’s reality” rightly so.....disease will take you out.
5. Fearless confidence is the absence of fear, replacing it with confidence which is trust in God and His Word.
6. God’s idea is for the believer to come to fullness and enjoy what He has promised.
