B. It is my firm belief that the Church should be training disciples to minister signs and wonders as the will of God to people everywhere.

1. This training should especially be keen to teach these disciples how to operate in the supernatural (spiritual) outside the four walls of the church.
2. When we do the will of God, we bring Kingdom reality crashing into the works of the devil. How does this work?
3. We initiate conflict between earthly reality and heavenly reality.
4. The moment the *conflict* is enacted *we become the bridge and connection with Heaven* and *the point of contact* that makes this type of ministry possible.
5. It is only through our prayer and radical obedience that we can assert the rulership of God.

III. Let me ask you a pointed question; aren't you tired of talking about a gospel of power, but never seeing it in action?

- A. Aren't you tired of trying to carry out the Great Commission without offering proof that the Kingdom works?
1. When we tell people that we represent the King and His Kingdom, but fail to act on its message, we are improperly representing Jesus and His message.
 2. Have we not missed the bulk of what Jesus taught?
 3. In the great commission Jesus said, **“These signs shall accompany them that believe: in my name shall they cast out demons; they shall speak**

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with new tongues; they shall take up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall in no wise hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.”

4. The word commission means: the act of granting certain powers or the authority to carry out a particular task or duty.
5. In order to expand the kingdom on this earth we are commissioned by Jesus and given the power and authority to carry out certain task and duties.
 - a. We are to cast out demons!
 - b. We are speak with new tongues!
 - c. We are to take up serpents with no hurt from their demonic poisons!
 - d. We are to lay hand on the on the sick, in order that they may recover!
6. We will never be able to complete it unless *we submit* to the idea that we are disciples of Christ and accept the fact that all of us are called to expand the Kingdom of Heaven on this earth in this manner.
7. Jesus taught and demonstrated that the Kingdom of God is a present reality, here and now.
 - a. Yes, it exists now in the invisible spiritual realm and is superior to everything in the natural visible realm.
 - b. Heaven’s reality establishes the fact that there is no such thing as the separation of disease and sickness from Satan.
 - c. Heaven’s reality today is the Garden of Eden before the fall of man.
